## A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE OHIO DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION TO INSTALL WRONG WAY DETECTION AT I-70 AND STATE ROUTE 256 WITHIN THE CITY OF PICKERINGTON LIMITS

**WHEREAS**, the City of Pickerington as the Local Public Agency ("LPA") and the State of Ohio ("ODOT") have identified the need to install wrong way detection at I-70 and State Route 256 within the City of Pickerington limits.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL  
OF THE CITY OF PICKERINGTON, FAIRFIELD-FRANKLIN  
COUNTIES, OHIO, A MAJORITY OF ITS MEMBERS  
CONCURRING:**

**Section 1. Consent Statement.** Being in the public interest, the LPA gives consent to the Director of Transportation to complete the above-described project.

**Section 2. Cooperation Statement.** The LPA shall cooperate with the Director of Transportation in the above-described project as follows:

The State shall assume and bear One Hundred Percent (100%) of all costs of the improvement.

The LPA further agrees to pay One Hundred Percent (100%) of the cost of those features requested by the LPA which are determined by the State and Federal Highway Administration to be unnecessary for the project.

**Section 3. Utilities and Right-of-Way Statement.** The LPA agrees that all right-of-way required for the described project will be acquired and/or made available in accordance with current State and Federal regulations. The LPA also understands that right-of-way costs include eligible utility costs.

**Section 4. Maintenance.** Upon completion of the described Project, and unless otherwise agreed, the LPA shall: (1) provide adequate maintenance for the described Project in accordance with all applicable state and federal law, including, but not limited to, 23 USC 116; (2) provide ample financial provisions, as necessary, for the maintenance of the Project; (3) maintain the right-of-way, keeping it free of obstructions; and (4) hold said right-of-way inviolate for public highway purposes.

**Section 5.** The City Manager is hereby directed to enter into any necessary contracts with ODOT in order to effectuate the intent of this Resolution.

**Section 6.** This Resolution shall take effect at the earliest time permitted by law.


