A RESOLUTION GRANTING THE CITY MANAGER THE AUTHORITY TO EVALUATE AND POSSIBLY REDUCE OR WAIVE CITY FEES THAT ARE ASSOCIATED WITH THE SCHOOL DISTRICT'S BUILDING OF A NEW JUNIOR HIGH SCHOOL AND ADDITIONS TO CENTRAL HIGH SCHOOL AND ITS ASSOCIATED FIELDS

WHEREAS, the Pickerington City Council authorizes the City Manager to evaluate and possibly reduce and/or waive City fees on behalf of the City with the Pickerington Local School District to help reduce the cost of associated City fees related to the building of a new junior high school and additions to Central High School and associated fields ("School Property"); and

WHEREAS, the City Council desires for the City Manager to evaluate and possibly reduce and/or waive City fees for the above stated purpose without any additional approval required by the City Council.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF PICKERINGTON, FAIRFIELD-FRANKLIN COUNTIES, OHIO, A MAJORITY OF ITS MEMBERS CONCURRING:

SECTION 1. The City Council hereby authorizes the City Manager to evaluate and possibly reduce and/or waive City fees on behalf of the City with the Pickerington Local School District related to new development on the School Property without any further Council action.

SECTION 2. This Resolution shall take effect immediately upon its adoption, and all prior resolutions or parts thereof inconsistent herewith, are hereby repealed.
