- 2. A letter of intent describing the rational for the Preliminary and Final Plat or Development Plan.
- 3. The appropriate per-phase fee payable to the City of Pickerington.

Important things to remember:

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- Plans must be folded; rolled plans will not be accepted
- The signature of both the applicant and the owner must be present if the applicant does not own the property.
- Impact fees will be required for all new commercial development or the expansion of existing commercial development in accordance with city code.
- By signing this document you agree to the submittal requirements of the plat or development plan for which you are applying.
