A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE DISPOSITION OF MUNICIPAL PERSONAL PROPERTY ACQUIRED VIA REAL ESTATE PURCHASES THAT IS NOT NEEDED FOR PUBLIC USE AND HAS NO APPARENT VALUE AT 80 LOCKVILLE ROAD, PICKERINGTON, OHIO 43147

WHEREAS, the City has recently completed several real estate purchases in Olde Pickerington Village in an effort to expand economic development in the area; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to these real estate purchases the City has acquired various personal property and fixtures within each location for which there is no public use and for which there is no apparent value; and

WHEREAS, Ohio Revised Code § 721.15 authorizes City Council to dispose of municipal personal property that is not needed for public use and has no apparent value to the City or its constituents; and

WHEREAS, the City administration has reviewed the personal property acquired pursuant to the real estate purchases and determined there is no public use and that such property has no apparent value.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF PICKERINGTON, FAIRFIELD-FRANKLIN COUNTIES, OHIO, A MAJORITY OF ITS MEMBERS CONCURRING:

SECTION 1. That City Council hereby directs the City Manager to take all steps necessary to dispose of the municipal personal property acquired by the City within 80 Lockville Road, Pickerington, Ohio 43147 pursuant to a recent real estate purchase.

SECTION 2. This Resolution shall take effect immediately upon its adoption, and all prior resolutions or parts thereof inconsistent herewith, are hereby repealed.
