A RESOLUTION TO DESIGNATE MUNICIPAL OWNED PROPERTY
ALONG DILEY ROAD AS "POSTAGE PARK" IN HONOR OF LOUIS V.
POSTAGE

WHEREAS, Louis V. Postage faithfully served the City of Pickerington and its residents for many years including as Mayor, City Council President, and the Chairman of the Rules, Safety, Service, and Finance Committees; and

WHEREAS, Mr. Postage passed away peacefully on May 26, 2026; and

WHEREAS, the City owns a triangle-shaped piece of land adjacent to Diley Road (identified as Fairfield County Parcel Numbers 0418248300, 0410254710, and 0410254700) and desires to name this parcel of land as "Postage Park" in honor of Mr. Postage and his lifelong dedication to the City of Pickerington; and

WHEREAS, the City intends that Postage Park shall be used for community and family enjoyment as a testament to Mr. Postage's passion for those values.

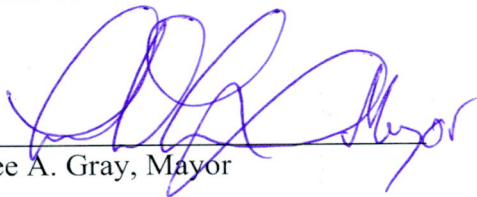
NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE

MAJORITY OF ITS MEMBERS CONCURRING:

SECTION 1. In honor of Lou Postage's lifetime of service and dedication to the City of Pickerington, City Council hereby bestows the community's appreciation upon him by naming the property along Diley Road as "Postage Park."

SECTION 2. The City Manager is hereby empowered to install all necessary signage at Postage Park and to update the City's register of publicly owned parks to reflect this name change.

SECTION 3. That this resolution shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.

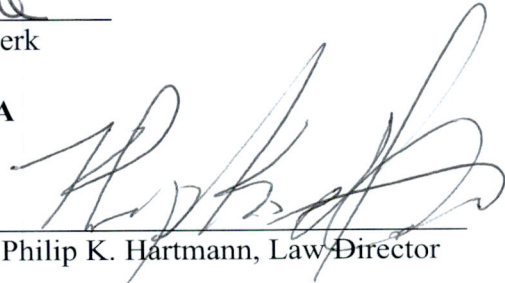
