Applicants must register to take the Police Officer entrance exam through the National Testing Network, Inc. (NTN) to establish an eligibility list for this position.

This test must be completed by October 3, 2025

Minimum Qualifications: Applicants must be 21 years of age on the date an employment offer is made, have a high school diploma or GED, corrected vision in both eyes to 20/20 and no color blindness, a valid driver's license with a good driving record, OPOTA certified, and an excellent employment history and background. Candidates are subject to extensive background checks, including criminal history checks, drug screening, and a truth verification test. *Extensive requirements and standards are located at www.ci.pickerington.oh.us

TO TEST: Enter into the hiring process by registering for testing at www.nationaltestingnetwork.com by designating the City of Pickerington as a reporting agency for test scores if you have not already done so in the past year. If you have taken the exam within one year of the recruitment deadline date, have NTN send us your score.

Only candidates who test by October 3, 2025, will be considered for this recruitment period. EOE/ADA

CANDIDATE SELECTION: The top twenty-ranked candidates from the NTN testing pool will be invited to continue in the recruitment process, provided NTN test scores are submitted to the City of Pickerington by 10/3/2025.

LATERAL HIRE PATROL OFFICER CANDIDATE INITIAL APPLICATION PROCESS: Candidates who believe they qualify as either a Level I or Level II lateral hire candidate should contact the Candidate Liaison Detective or the Operations Division Commander for a lateral application at (614) 575-6911.

Lateral applications must be submitted by 5:00 p.m. on Friday, October 3, 2025, at the Pickerington Police Department - 1311 Refugee Road, 43147.
